

Football helpful hints

Always carry a spare whistle
Carry a plastic sandwich bag for your check, you will sweat or it may rain
Clean and shine your shoes at home not in the locker room

Linesman, carry a zip tie tucked in your cap band in case the chain breaks
Linesman carry an extra clip, a small one from the hardware store will do
A piece of red ribbon tied on the chain next to the tape will make it easier to find the tape
Make sure you have the left and right shoe (do not ask why I know this)
Pack your own bag; do not have your wife do this
Have a timing device (watch) handy
Have at least 2 complete uniforms
Extra pair of shoe laces
Roll of white tape for the chain
A separate bag, trash bag for your shoes
A large trash bag for that muddy, rainy field and just cram you uniform in it
Hand warmers for that very cold game
Extra pencils and a pencil sharpener
Sunscreen
Rubber bands
Safety pins for when the zipper breaks
Use and learn the words and language in the rule book, not fans language
Spray Pam on the bottom of your shoes and the grass will fall off at the end of the game
Know where to park at the school and back in the parking space
A drier sheet (Bounce) put in the cap keeper with you hat will keep it fresh
